

MICHIGAN JUSTIN MORGAN HORSE ASSOCIATION \$500.00 SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The MJMHA shall establish two yearly scholarship(s) in the amount of \$500 each. One scholarship will be for graduating High School Seniors that have been accepted to a college, university or trade school; the second is for college, university or trade school under graduates (through the age of 22) which will be used towards books, or tuition, at the college, university or trade school that the high school graduate has been accept to and the under graduate attends. The payment will be made directly to the college, university or trade school 30 days before classes start. Students who receive a full 100% (academic, athletic, fraternal, or other) from another provider are not eligible for this program. The MJMHA Board of Directors does not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, age, religious affiliation, national origin, or disability. The MJMHA Board of Directors or part of, will consider all applications submitted. Please note that it is not incumbent that all scholarship(s) will be awarded if there are not enough qualified applicants nominated.

The winner(s) of the scholarship will be announced annually at the Michigan All Morgan Horse Show.

Essay Question

What life lessons have you learned from your exposure to the Morgan Horse and how will you apply them in your adult life? Essay should be 500 words or less, typed and double spaced.

Judging Criteria and Process

The MJMHA BOD will consider the perceived value the scholarship may have on the recipient's future. Applications are judged blind, meaning the judges do not know the identity of each applicant.

All applications are judged independently on the following scale:

1-3: Satisfactory 4-5: Good 6-8: Excellent 9-10: Outstanding

Each judge/director rates all the essays individually and gives them a score of 1-10 using the above scale. Their ratings are then given to the Administrator of the Scholarship Committee for tabulation. Each applicant's three scores are added together with additional participation information from the application and the scholarship is awarded to the applicant(s) with the highest tabulated score.

Eligibility Requirements

The candidate must be a member (family or individual) in good standing for the past 3 years.

The candidate must have attended/participated, but not necessarily exhibited at some of the MJMHA Events listed on the application during the past 3 years.

For the first scholarship the candidate must be a senior in high school, graduate or the equivalent there of and been accepted to a college, university or trade school. For the second scholarship the candidate must be an under graduate at a college, university or trade school that has not reached their 23rd birthday by December 1st of the preceding year.

Scholarship applicants must have their completed application and essay to the Scholarship Administrator no later than **May 15th** of the year of application. Please send to:
